Overview - Christine

- Started in January 2005 in South Dakota
- Curbs substance use among DWI offenders
- Provides alternative to incarceration
- Twice a day breath testing
- Swift and certain sanction for violations
- Reduces recidivism
- Improves public safety by reducing criminal behavior and motor vehicle crashes

THE POWER OF ACCOUNTABILITY



24/7 is not a treatment program.

24/7 is a program to demonstrate accountability and to show that clients can be sober, responsible, and safe in the community.

WHAT SETS 24/7 APART

Transparent

• Expectations should be clear and defined.

Consistent

• There are no **modifications**, **substitutions**, or **exceptions**.

Immediate

• Response to noncompliance or infraction is **swift** and **systematic**.

Certain

• Beyond doubt. No question. **Assured.**

SWIFT & CERTAIN SANCTIONS

Improve Accountability and Abstinence

Lancaster County 24/7 Sobriety Program Participant Agreement



- 24. I understand there will be an IMMEDIATE sanction for any behavior that violates the rules of the 24/7 Sobriety Program. Below is a list of the expected sanctions should I have a violation. I understand that this list does NOT cover every possible violation.
 - ANY POSITIVE TEST (PBT, UA/Oral Fluid Device with admitted use or lab confirmed, confirmed SCRAM report):
 - First Violation (<u>PBT/Admitted Use</u>): 12 hours at The Bridge detox facility or until my PBT is .000 (whichever is longer). If The Bridge is full, 12 hours in the Lancaster County Jail
 - First Violation (UA, lab confirmed): 12 hours jail at the Lancaster County Jail
 - 2. Second Violation: 24 hours in the Lancaster County Jail
 - 3. Third Violation: Minimum of 48 hours in the Lancaster County Jail (must remain in custody pending bond review)
 - ii. LATE TO TEST (less than 30 minutes):
 - 1. First Violation: Verbal Warning
 - 2. Second Violation: 4 hours community service
 - 3. Third Violation: 24 hours in the Lancaster County Jail
 - 4. Fourth Violation: Minimum of 48 hours in the Lancaster County Jail (must remain in custody pending bond review)
 - iii. ADULTERATION OF A TEST, (substitution, tampering with monitoring equipment, etc.):
 - 1. First Violation: Minimum of 48 hours in the Lancaster County Jail (must remain in custody pending bond review)
 - iv. MISSING A TEST (30 minutes late or more):
 - 1. First Violation: 24 hours in the Lancaster County Jail
 - 2. Second Violation: Minimum of 48 hours in the Lancaster County Jail (must remain in custody pending bond review)
 - ABSCONDING FROM THE 24/7 PROGRAM (i.e., providing a positive test then leaving the testing area, missing two or more consecutive tests, leaving The Bridge before completion of 12-hour sanction):
 - *A warrant will be requested, then upon apprehension*:
 - 1. First Violation: Placement in the Lancaster County Jail (must remain in custody pending bond review)
 - vi. <u>NEW FELONY and/or MISDEMEANOR CHARGE</u> (related to possession or consumption of alcohol, marijuana, or other controlled substance):
 - First Violation: Placement in the Lancaster County Jail (must remain in custody pending bond review)

Initial 24/7 Bond \$3,500 %

24/7 PARTICIPATION

- December 15th, 2021 June 12th, 2023
- 1090 Breathalyzers
- Over 80 random Uas
- 8 Violations
- 3 separate bond reviews to continue participation

OUTCOME

- Amended charges to DUI-.08 -3rd Offense (Misdemeanor)
- 90 Days in jail.
- Received approval for District Court House Arrest
- \$1,000 Fine
- 15 year License revocation

Alex - DUI .15+ or refusal (2 prior convictions)

- 1/20/22 1st missed test, 24 hours at the Lancaster County Jail
- 2/06/22 1st positive PBT, 12 hours at The Bridge
- 2/25/22 2nd positive PBT, 24 hours at The Lancaster County Jail
- 2/28/22 1st late test, provided verbal warning
- 3/27/22 3rd positive PBT, 48 hours at The Lancaster County Jail
- 5/1/222 4th positive PBT, 48 hours at The Lancaster County Jail
- 7/24/22 5th positive PBT, 48 hours at The Lancaster County Jail
- 9/24/22 2nd late test, 4- Hours of Community Service (Completed)

Brandon

Initial Bond: \$50,000 %

DUI-.08 - 4TH OFFENSE (180days -3years)

24/7 PARTICIPATION

- \$20,000 % Bond
- December 18th, 2025 January 9th, 2025
- 776 Breathalyzers
- 50+ Random UAs
- No 24/7 Violations
- Completed Intensive Out-patient Treatment and MRT through the Community Corrections office

OUTCOME

- Sentenced to 365 days for first charge
- Amended second charge to resist arrest 1st offense 90 days
- Dropped third charge
- Concurrent sentences will serve 190 days.
- At sentencing Judge stated

"I take these charges very seriously, and I want you to understand that your efforts on 24/7 have deeply mitigated your sentence today."

KEY TAKE AWAYS

- Build relationships with your MDT
- Consistency is KEY
- Success can have sanctions
